SMILEFAST STYLOSO: PREDICTABLE LAB MADE COMPOSITE VENEERS WITH MINIMAL PREP

Using resin composite to place direct veneers onto teeth has revolutionised the way we deliver smile makeovers in an efficient and predictable way. However, there are times when placing resin direct to teeth will not achieve the desired results either we or our patients are looking for. In certain situations, using additive only direct resin is not the ideal treatment option, and lab-made veneers are the preferred alternative. This has historically meant that the teeth require extensive preparation, and the procedure becomes time-consuming and costly to both us and our patients.

The SmileFast Styloso project was conceived and developed to offer an alternative to this; to be able to provide our patients a lab-made veneer option which didn't require the same level of tooth preparation as ceramic veneers, nor the extended time or the increased costs involved – yet still provide a predictable and beautiful smile.

In addition to experiencing this new protocol, you will learn essential fundamentals to perfect veneers; being the lab communication and planning, the tooth preparation sequence, and finally the cementation protocol. A grounded understanding of these three fundamentals will empower you to deliver predictable high-end restorations with confidence.

In addition to this, there will be discussion of steps involved in restoration of a highly aesthetic single central crown which involved close communication with the dental technician.
