Provisional restorations are no longer simple temporaries, they are a decisive clinical tool that guides esthetics, function, biology, and communication throughout restorative treatment.

This one-day masterclass focuses on contemporary provisional techniques for veneers and crowns, highlighting how different clinical approaches influence the final outcome.

- Understand the biologic and esthetic role of provisional restorations in soft tissue management.
- Differentiate between provisionalization strategies for veneers, crowns, and fixed partial dentures.
- Apply principles of emergence profile design for optimal tissue conditioning and stability.
- Recognize the influence of contour, texture, and cervical design on peri-restorative soft tissue behavior.
- Compare analog and digital workflows for fabrication of provisional restorations.
- Understand indications, advantages, and limitations of printed provisional restorations.
- Integrate printed provisionals into contemporary restorative workflows for improved efficiency and predictability.
- Improve communication protocols between clinician, technician, and patient during the provisional phase.
- Utilize provisional restorations as a diagnostic and communication tool for functional and esthetic validation.
- Develop predictable protocols for transitioning from provisional to definitive restorations while preserving soft tissue architecture.

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
